2025-2026 Information Packet

ASI's Arts Access program aims to break the barriers of inaccessibility to the arts which are often money, transportation, and knowledge of events. We partner with local theaters, galleries, and other arts and culture organizations to offer free or reduced-cost opportunities to Western New Yorkers. Eligibility is open to anyone receiving income-based public assistance in WNY. Passes are honored at our 60+ partner locations. Additionally, ASI offers free safe transportation to and from events upon request.

How to use your pass

- 1 Check Availability**

To check if a program event has tickets available, please contact the admissions or box office of your selected venue. For general admission, call at least 48 hours in advance due to capacity limits or scheduled tours. For ticketed events, call as soon as you know about the event to confirm availability.
- 2 Provide Your Member ID Number:**

When calling or visiting, provide your First and Last Name, Arts Access member ID number shown on your pass. If applicable, provide your preferred day/time/event.
- 3 Understand Reservation Policies:**

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and based on availability. You may not always get your preferred date or event. Arts Access partners donate tickets based on their budget and, typically, with limited quantity.
- 4 Reserve Transportation (optional):**

ASI provides free, safe, and accessible transportation in Erie and Niagara county through our partners at [Hart Transportation](#) to and from partner events. Ride reservations must be made through the Arts Access office **at least 2 weeks** before your event date. See details below for how to make a reservation.
- 5 Stay Informed:**

Always check with the partner organization for the most up-to-date information. Especially as it relates weather policy, cancellations, and postponement.

Additional Considerations

Renewals:

Your membership is valid for one year, with the expiration date listed on your pass. To stay enrolled, reapply each year to confirm eligibility. Renewal can be completed online, by mail, or in person.

Return Visits:

To ensure all passholders can access events, most partner locations limit how many times per month a passholder can visit.

Cancellation Policies:

- Venue Reservations: If you reserve tickets and cannot pick them up or use them, please call and tell the box office or main office as soon as possible. Repeated failure to use reserved tickets may result in your pass being revoked.
- Transportation: Advanced notice of a minimum of 48 hours is required for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended.

New Partners:

Arts Access is always adding new partners. Make sure to check the website for the most up-to-date partner information: www.arts-access.org/partner-organizations.

Lost Pass:

If your pass has been lost, misplaced or damaged, you can submit a request for a replacement. Your pass must still be active and not expired. Visit (www.arts-access.org/lost-card) or call (716) 833-3004 x514 to have a replacement mailed. If your card has expired, please renew your pass online, in-person, or by mail.

Transportation

Transportation requests are to be booked at least **two weeks in advance** online at: arts-access.org/transportation.

Kindly refrain from calling drivers or the transportation company for new requests as your ride will not be free. Please note that our service operates on a scheduled basis with limited availability. Last minute requests may not be accommodated.

Cancellations: Advanced notice of a minimum of **48 hours is required** for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended. To cancel, email artsaccess@asiwny.org.

By requesting a ride, you agree to adhere to our code of conduct.

Transportation Code of Conduct

- **Reservation Policy:**
 - Transportation is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Passholders may reserve up to two trips per month, subject to calendar availability.
 - Requests must be made at least 2 weeks before your event date.
 - Pickup and return times cannot be changed within 48 hours of your trip.
 - Transportation is not confirmed until you hear back from the Arts Access Office.
- **Cancellation Policy:**
 - Advanced notice of a minimum of 48 hours is required for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended.
- **Sanitation Policy:**
 - To maintain cleanliness and safety, please refrain from eating, drinking, smoking, or vaping in the vehicle.
- **Accompanied Minors:**
 - Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. If a child requires a car seat, you are responsible for providing and installing it in the vehicle.
- **Passholder Presence:**
 - The passholder who made the transportation request must be present for the trip.
- **Safety Measures:**
 - Always wear a seatbelt. Refrain from distracting behavior. Services animals only.
- **Courtesy and Respect:**
 - Please be courteous to those making reservations and driving the vehicles. Be ready to go at the time and location you provided in your request.

Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in the termination of transportation privileges.
