How to use your pass

Choose Your Partner (We have over 70!)

After choosing a participating partner, review the partner information to see how their ticketing is handled (consult packet or our website). If no reservations are required, bring your pass to the venue and present it upon arrival. To see if an event or performance has tickets available, please contact the partner directly (Arts Access is not responsible for ticketing).

Provide Your Member ID Number:

When calling or emailing, provide your Name and Arts Access member ID number shown on your pass. If visiting in person, present your pass.

Understand Reservation Policies:

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, and based on availability. You may not always get your preferred date or event. Arts Access partners donate tickets based on their budget and, typically, with limited quantity.

Reserve Transportation (optional):

ASI provides free, safe, and accessible transportation. Ride reservations must be made through the Arts Access office at least 2 weeks before your event date. See details on back for how to make a reservation.

Stay Informed:

Always check with the partner organization for the most up-to-date information, especially as it relates to weather policy, cancellations, and postponement.

Additional Considerations

Renewals:

Your membership is valid for one year, with the expiration date listed on your pass. To stay enrolled, reapply each year to confirm eligibility. Renewal can be completed online, by mail, or in person.

Cancellation Policies:

- Venue Reservations: If you reserve tickets and cannot pick them up or use them, please call and tell the box office or main office as soon as possible. Repeated failure to use reserved tickets may result in your pass being revoked.
- Transportation: Advanced notice of a minimum of 48 hours is required for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended.

New Partners:

Arts Access is always adding new partners. Make sure to check the website for the most up-to-date partner information: arts-access.org/partner-organizations.

Lost Pass:

If your pass has been lost, misplaced or damaged, you can submit a request for a replacement. Your pass must still be active and not expired. Visit: arts-access.org/lost-card or call (716) 833-3004 x514 to have a replacement mailed. If your card has expired, please renew your pass online, in-person, or by mail.

Transportation

Transportation requests are to be booked **at least two weeks in advance** online at: arts-access.org/transportation or calling (716) 833-3004 x514.

Kindly refrain from calling drivers or the transportation company for new requests as your ride will not be free. Please note that our service operates on a scheduled basis with limited availability. Last minute requests may not be accommodated.

Cancellations: Advanced notice of a minimum of **48 hours is required** for all cancelled rides. Failure to comply may result in your transportation privileges being suspended. To cancel, email artsaccess@asiwny.org or call (716) 833-3004 x514.

Arts Access Transportation Code of Conduct

Ride reservations can only be made through the Arts Access office, do not call drivers or the transportation company to schedule a new transportation request. Please note that our transportation service is not “on demand,” but scheduled via calendar.

Transportation is on a first-come, first serve basis. Passholders may reserve up to one trip per month, or based on calendar availability. Requests must be made at least 2 weeks in advance of your event date. Transportation fills up quickly, so it is advised that you book early.

By requesting a ride, you agree to our code-of-conduct:

Pickup and return times cannot be changed 48 hours before your trip. Transportation is not confirmed until you have received a call back from the Arts Access office regarding your request. You may cancel or reschedule your ride up to 48 hours before your scheduled trip. If you do not cancel or reschedule your ride before 48 hours, you will be subject to losing transportation privileges. “No-shows” the day of will also be subject to losing transportation privileges.

Hart Transportation will confirm your ride up to 24 hours before pick-up. Failure to confirm with Hart Transportation will result in a cancelled ride. Please make sure to answer the phone call, allow for voicemail messages, or call back to keep your ride.

Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. If a child requires a special seat, you are responsible for providing and installing it in the vehicle.

The passholder who made the transportation request must be present for the trip. While friends and family may ride with you, you cannot reserve rides for them.

Passholders are responsible for their behavior as well as their guests’ behavior. Any abusive language or behavior will result in termination of transportation privileges.

Always wear a seatbelt. No pets except for certified Service Animals.

To keep vans clean and safe for all riders, no eating, drinking, or smoking is allowed.

Please be courteous to anyone who answers the phones or drives the vehicles. It is helpful to have pickup times and locations ready for drivers so as to not rush them. Our transportation partner provides a valuable service to the community and they must be treated with respect. Failure to do so will result in termination of transportation privileges.

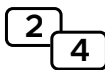
